Acacia implexa	Lightwood	5-10m	4-8m	A smaller verion of the Blackwood but growing in dryer climates and is very hardy.	
Acacia iteaphylla	flinders range wattle	3-4m	2-3m	Attractive hardy shrub with blue gry foliage, tollerating dry conditions	
Acacia longifolia	Sallow Wattle	3-8m	3-5m	fast growing useful screen Tree;useful bushfood shrub for seed	
Acacia bailyana purperae	Cootamundra wattle, purple foliage form.	3-6m	3-5m	Fast growing attractive small tree with blue/ purple foliage and bright yellow call flowers.	
Acacia dealbata	Silver Wattle	8-15 m	3-10m	Fast growing pioneer plant sometimes used as a furniture timber as well as fire wood.	
Acacia mearnsii	Black Wattle	10-20m	5-8m	fast growing tree ,useful firewood and timber.	
Acacia myrtifolia	Myrtle Wattle	1-1.5m	1-1.5m	Great for reveg or landscape. A small wattle with bright yellow flowers.	
Acacia provincialis	wirilda wattle	5-8m	2-4m	Grows in seasonaly waterlogged soils, seed are used as a high protein food source but the shrubs are also usefull as a shelter tree in farm plantations.	
Acacia pycnantha	Golden Wattle	3-6m	2-3m	attractive tree useful for edble wattle seed.	
Acacia verticillata	Prickly Moses	3-6m	2-5m	good habitat shrub with yellow rod shaped flowers	
Acacia stricta	Hop Wattle	2-3m	2m	Small attractive wattle with pale yellow flowers	
Banksia marginata	Silver Banksia, Tree Form.	3-7m	2-4m	hardy windbreak tree; a good bird attracter	
Bedfordia arborescence	Blanket leaf	5-10m	3-5m	growing in the forested foothills it has unusual furry foliage and attractive yellow flowers.	
Bursaria spinosa	Sweet Bursaria	3-6m	2-3m	attractive cream flower tht are usefull for attracting benefical insects	
Calistemon pinifolus		1-3m	2-3m	Attractive pink bottle brushes with yellow styles, a great bird attracter	
Callistemon violacia	Majenta Bottlebrush	1.5-3m	1.5-2m	Compact bottle brush good for bees and birds	
Callistemon citrinus	Crimson Bottle Brush	2-3m	2-3m	A bright crimson bottlebrush ,great bird attracter	
Callistemon viminalis	Weeping Bottle Brush	3-5m	3-4m	Attractive weeping habit with dark red bottle bruch flowers	
Callistemon sieberi	River Bottlebrush	2-3m	1-2m	useful shrub in a reveg mix or sheltre belt .lemon flowers,	
Caprosma quadrifida	native current bush	2-4m	1-3m	Small bushy shrub when grown on the open, but also grows as an understory shrub and is taller and more open. This shrub produces masses of tasteey edible red berries.	
Cassinea aculeata	Dogwood	2-3m	2-3m	Useful pioneer plant for revegetation.	
Olearia Argophyla	Musk daisy Bush	3-6m	3-4m	An attractive understory small tree with white under side of the leaves and large clusters of cream flowers.	5cm tube
Olearia lirata	Snowy Daisy Bush	2-3m	2-3m	Fast growing pioneer shrub with showy white flowers	5cm tube
Prostanthera mollisifolia	Balm Mint Bush	2-5m	2-3m	Attractive shrub with a mint aroma and bright purple flowers	5cm tube
Ozothamnus Ferrigenus	Tree everlasting	4-6m	3-4m	Fast growing pioneer shrub ,usefull in revegetation.	
Solanum aviculare	Kangaroo Apple	2-3m	2-3m	fast growing pioneer plant.

Continale	Prickly Tea Tree	2-5m	1-3m	Masses of white flowers in December, good for attracting benefical insects	
Lanigerum	Woolly Tea Tree	3-5m	2-3m	bluish foliage ,attractive white flowers providing fodder for benefical insects. Good in wet areas.	
Rotundifolia	Pink Beauty	1-2m	1-2m	large pink to mauve flowers.attractive for bees and other insects.

Decussata	Totem Poles	2-3m	2-4m	Hardy shrub suits most soil types produces attractive mauve flowers
Hypericifolia	Hillock Bush	2-3m	2-4m	Attractive weeping habit with large orange bottlebrushes, a great dense screen shrub.
Lanceolata	Moonah	2-4m	3-4m	Hardy dense shrub with masses of cream flowers. Ideal screen and windbreak.
Linariafolia	Snow In Summer	3-5m	2-4m	A dense screen tree with a compact habit and masses of white flowers in summer.
Squarosa	scented paperbark	2-4m	2-3m	A lemon flowered small shrub growing well in wet areas
Halmaturorum	Kangaroo Island paperbark	3-6m	2.5-5m	large spreading shrub with papery bark and white flowers in spring. Salt tolerant and useful screening tree.
<b>Sedges</b>				
Carex appressa	Tall Sedge	1m	1m	great in wet areas with attractive brown seed heads. Good habitat for small birds.
<b>Rushes</b>				
Ficinia nodosa	Knobby Club Rush	0.6-1m	0.3-1m	Useful for landscape or habitat. Seed heads form brown knobs on the ends of the foliage.
Juncus palidus	Pale Rush	1-1.5m	0.5-1m	tall erect rush grows well in wet areas.
Lomandra longifolia	Matt Rush	0.6-1m	0.5-1m	growing locally in southeastern Australia often under eucalypts and often used as a landscape plant. It also provides good habitat for small lizards, frogs and birds
<b>Grasses and herbs</b>				
Austrostipa	Spear Grass	0.5-1.2m	0.3m	A native grass with attractive weeping seedheads
Austrodanthonia caespitosa	Common Wallby Grass	0.2-0.3m		A native grass that attracts beneficial insects to a site.
Microtena stipoides	weeping grass	2-3m	0.3	A native grass that has potential as a lawn; lasting well in dry conditions
Poa polytrichoides	Coastal Tussock Grass	1m	0.8m	A tussock grass that grows close to the coast and tolerates salt air. Often a blue grey colour
Poa labillardera	Silver Tussock Grass	1m	1m	A tall tussock grass often used in landscaping or stabilising soil.
<b>Trees</b>				
Acacia melanoxylon	Blackwood	5-20m	2-10m	A medium tree used for high quality furniture timber
Corymbia maculata	Spotted Gum	10-35m	6-15m	A tall smooth barked tree forming a spotted or dappled appearance on the trunk. A valuable timber or landscape tree with many uses both in the landscape or for firewood or specialty timber.
Allocasuarina glauca	Swamp Sheoak	5-20m	3-6m	A popular tree for wet areas but also grows in the dry where it produces thickets due to suckering habit.
Allocasuarina littoralis	Black She Oak	4-8m	2-4m	attractive tree useful in windbreaks with attractive timber
Allocasuarina verticulata	Drooping Sheoak	4-10m	3-6m	withstands coastal winds and provides valuable timber and firewood
E. brookeriana	Brookers Gum	20-40m	10-15m	A very fast growing timber tree growing in pockets throughout the Otways. Older trees have produced quality fire wood.
E. aromifolia	Scentbark	10-20m	8-10m	A rough barked tree with bluish green leaves with a distinctive peppermint aroma.
E. dives	Broad Leaf Peppermint	10-15m	8-10m	Small tree, leaves are high in oil and used commercially.

E.leucoxyton ssp. bellarinensis	Bellarine Yellow Gum	<b>Height</b> 8-12m	<b>Width</b> 5-8m	An attractive endangered species endemic to the Bellarine peninsular useful for shelter and wildlife	
Eucalyptus botryoides	Southern Marhogany	10-30m	5-10m	A great furniture timber for heavy soils producing a rich red timber when mature.	
E. caesia ssp. magna	Silver Princess	3-6m	2-3m	Attractive weeping habit with the upper part of the branches having a powdery silver effect and drooping pink flowers.	
E. camaldulensis	River Redgum	10-30m	10-20m	A tall Tree growing well in heavy soils and producing a dense red durable timber	
E. cypellocarpa	Mountain Grey Gum	10-35m	10-15m	An attractive tree with grey smooth bark and dense wood making it good for both fire wood or timber.	
E.globulus	Blue gum	25-35m	10-15m	Tall fast growing timber tree.	
E.cladocalyx	Sugar Gum	20-35m	10-15m	A great tree used for both firewood production, a vey dense timber as well as shelter.	
E. olida	Strawberry Gum	10-12m	6m	Used for flavouring in teas and herb mixes as well as oil production	
E. leucoxyton rosea dwarf		3-6m	2-4m	This is one of the most popular shelter trees due to thw wide range of soil types it thrives in , the attractive pink flowers and its bushy habit of growth.	
E leucoxyton rosea	Pink Flowering Yellow Gum	7-10m	4-6m	A taller growing form with small tree like features and bright pink to red flowers.	
E. meuleriana	Yellow Stringy Bark	20-30m	6-10m	This tree is a popular timber tree producing a highly durable timber.	
E. meliodora	Yellow Box	20-30m	10-15m	Highly durable timber and Honey producing tree	
E.occidentalis	Swamp Yate	10-20m	5-15m	A very hardy tree in heavy soils also producing excellent fire wood.	
E.obliqua	Messmate	15-30m	10-15m	A fibrouse barked eucalypt that grows on a wide variety of soils and climates producing poular timber and firewood.	
E.ovata	Swamp Gum	10-30m	5-10m	Does well in wet areas. Growing in a wide range of soil types	
E.platypus	Platypus gum	5-6m	3-4m	Fast growing small bushy tree suited to heavy soils	
E.radiata	Narrow Leaf Pepermint	10-25m	10-15m	Found growing on sany grounds it has a fibrous bark and fine leaves.	
E. Regnans	Mountain Ash	30-40m	15-25m	Tall timber tree in high rainfall areas	
E.saligna	Sydney Bluegum	20-30m	5-15m	A clean barked furniture timber tree, producing a red timber sort after for cabinet making.	
E. spathulata	Swamp mallet	8-10m	5-8m	a small low branching tree with Smooth coppery bark.Withstands harsh dry conditions.	
E. tricarpa	Red Ironbark	15-25m	10-15m	With its dark fissured bark and attractive red very durable timber make Tricarpa a valued farm tree especialy in dryer areas.	
E.yarraensis	Yarra Gum	15-30m	10-15m	An un common tree that is always good in a mix growing in the otway foothills.	
E.viminalis	Manna Gum	20-35m	10-20m	A clean trunk but with long ribbons of bark when shedding it. The prefered Koala fodder tree grows naturaly in damper landscapes.
